6. Gavi performance based funding: The Programme shall be subject to Gavi's performance-based funding (PBF). Under HSS support will be split into two payments: the programmed payment (based on implementation of the Programme) and the performance payment (based on improve immunisation outcomes). This means that in the first year, Country will receive 100% year one annual amount, as an upfront payment. After year one, countries will receive the annual amount, based on implementation of the grant. Note that countries whose grant budget would fall below US\$3 million are exempt from this 80% rule. Country will have the opportunity to receive payments beyond the programme budge for exceptional performance. Such performance payments will be based on performa immunisation outcome indicators. Gavi calculation of performance payments for 2015 achievements – TOTALS:

Given that Country's DTP3 coverage was **below 90% at baseline**, which is defined as the year prior to the first year of HSS grant implementation, and based on WHO/UNICEF estimates, Country will be rewarded for improving coverage with:

- \$30 per additional child immunised with DTP3, if DTP3 coverage increases and
- \$30 per additional child immunised with first dose of measles containing vaccine, if measles coverage increases.
