# 2019: a record-breaking year for childhood immunisation

The year 2019 saw significant progress in Gavi's work to support health systems:

- countries delivered a record number of routine vaccinations – more than 230 million
- ☑ Gavi disbursed a record US\$ 331 million in health system support

Gavi supported efforts to bring forward the world's first Ebola vaccine, which, as of December 2019, helped protect over 260,000 people in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

In 2019, Gavi-supported countries invested more in our immunisation partnership than ever before, contributing a total of US\$ 102 million towards the co-financing of Gavi-supported vaccines.

The successes of 2019 are a testament to the power of the Vaccine Alliance – from our core partners to the dedicated, passionate people in countries and communities upon whose hard work and expertise we rely every day to protect the next generation.






- Emergency stockpiles are an essential tool to contain outbreaks and protect affected communities. In 2019, thanks to @Gavi and partners, >28 million stockpile doses were shipped to protect people from cholera, meningococcal meningitis and yellow fever: https://bit.ly/35qRJyB
- Over the past four years, the average number of @Gavi-supported vaccines that a child receives through routine immunisation has nearly doubled – meaning that more children are protected against more serious diseases than ever before! #VaccinesWork https://bit.ly/35qRJyB
- In 2019, stockpiles for cholera, meningococcal and yellow fever vaccines were accessed a total of 22 times by 12 countries. Stockpiles can be quickly deployed to protect affected communities. Read more about @Gavi's work to quickly contain outbreaks: https://bit.ly/35qRJyB



## **SOCIAL MEDIA MESSAGES**

- In 2019, @Gavi disbursed a record
  US\$ 331 million in health system support
  - This unprecedented funding saw countries deliver a record number of routine vaccinations over 230 million to protect children in the countries where it is most needed. https://bit.ly/35qRJyB
- Coverage of one dose of pentavalent vaccine – which protects children against five major diseases - increased to 87% in 2019 within @Gavi-supported countries. This means more children are protected by life-saving vaccines! #VaccinesWork https://bit.ly/35qRJyB





- With @Gavi support, countries are building sustainable immunisation programmes by co-financing vaccines to enhance country ownership of vaccine programmes. Since 2008, more than US\$1 billion has been paid by countries in co-financing contributions! https://bit.ly/35qRJyB
- Countries have self-financed vaccine programmes introduced with @Gavi support valued at US\$ 204 million in 2019, bringing the total estimated value of country investments in self-financed programmes to more than US\$ 0.7 billion! #VaccinesWork https://bit.ly/35qRJyB
