Under this, the S support will be split into two payments: the programmed payment (based on blementation of the Programme) and the performance payment (based on improvements ir nunisation outcomes). This means that in the first year, Country will receive 100% of the ar one annual amount, as an upfront payment. After year one, countries will receive 80% of annual amount, based on implementation of the grant. Note that countries whose total int budget would fall below US\$3 million are exempt from this 80% rule.
