Gavi Policy: Fragility, Emergencies, Refugees Monitoring Framework DRAFT

Implementation of the Gavi Policy on Fragility, Emergencies and Refugees will be monitored by the Secretariat

This framework is a first attempt to outline outcomes and outputs that the Alliance will monitor throughout the implementation of the policy. This framework would not represent an additional reporting burden to countries and Alliance partners as it leverages existing processes and data sources. Where relevant, Alliance Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) are used. The monitoring would by and large be annual whilst the tracking of flexibilities would be done on a quarterly basis.

In addition, the Secretariat would include regular (qualitative) updates on the implementation of this policy in the Country Programmes Update to the PPC and Board.

An external evaluation of the policy is planned for 2019 as part of a broader evaluation of Gavi's Country Engagement Framework (CEF) in order to assess its effectiveness, efficiency, and results.
