Current status

- December 2015 forecast still valid
- All decisions can be approved by the Board in accordance with the Programme Funding Policy as resources available to fund through 2020
- 2011-15 \$ 6.86bn (London est. \$6.83bn)
- 2015 FY 90% of FY est.
- 2016 Q1 23% of FY est. (27% in 2015)
- Envelopes: Allotments were within Board mandated amounts

- Committee member commitment and 2016 work plan
- AFC charter review
- Skills required for AFC members e.g. risk, finance
- Operating expense ratio
- Risk management

Reflection on Board Retreat discussion and follow-up



Board Retreat key take-aways

Informed risk discussion on vaccine wastage

- Endorsed risk appetite, comfortable with current exposure, acknowledged future exposure may increase
- Important to strengthen data quality and potentially reinforce mitigation in high risk countries

Risk oversight arrangements

- Agreed AFC will coordinate and ensure all risks are owned and overseen by Committees
- Important to ensure that every Committee has capabilities to oversee risks in their areas

Risk reporting needs

- Requested concise update at every Board meeting, and full report in December
- Requested a top-down report which shows issues and trends, with top risks to be categorised, quantified, and prioritised
- Agreed on optional deep-dives on specific risks, to be selected from Risk and Assurance Report
