Amendment to the Programme Funding Policy

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Background

- Opportunity to streamline processes
- "Rolling" basis for HSFP proposals from 2012
 requires more frequent funding allotments
- Need for timely operational adjustments to budgets – between committee meetings
- Essential to maintain due governance
 while improving operational efficiency



Proposed approach

- Board/EC approves funding:
 - GAVI support for all new vaccine proposals at the outset; and
 - Envelope to maintain support each subsequent year
- Secretariat allots:
 - For ongoing maintenance of support (per IRC recommendations and operational adjustments)
 - For new HSFP proposals (because of frequency and size)

And reports back to Board and AFC twice a year

Timeline example

- December 2012: Board approves envelope for funding allotments to be made during 2013
- Acting on IRC recommendations throughout 2013, Secretariat allots funding to:
 - Endorse amounts of new HSFP proposals starting in 2013/2014
 - Adjust previously endorsed amounts
 - Extend endorsed amounts for renewed Multi-Year Plans (running from 2014)
 - Establish liabilities for 2014



Pros and cons

- Ability to align with country cycles (for HSFP)
 without additional committee meetings
- Timely adjustment of resources allocated – for changes in timing, price, etc.
- Potential perception of diluted governance
 - transfers responsibilities to Secretariat
 - with specific safeguards
