Context: Mpox outbreak



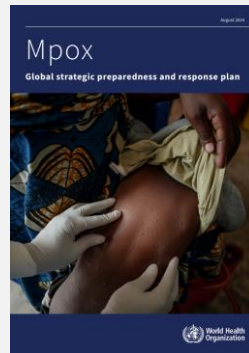
Latest epidemiology*



- 11,148 confirmed cases (85% of these in DRC)
- 53 confirmed deaths (81% of these in DRC)
- 19 affected countries



Strategic response



Phase I: Stop outbreaks - Focuses on interrupting transmission by vaccinating contacts of recent cases and healthcare/ frontline workers in areas with active outbreaks.

Phase II: Expand protection

Funding landscape



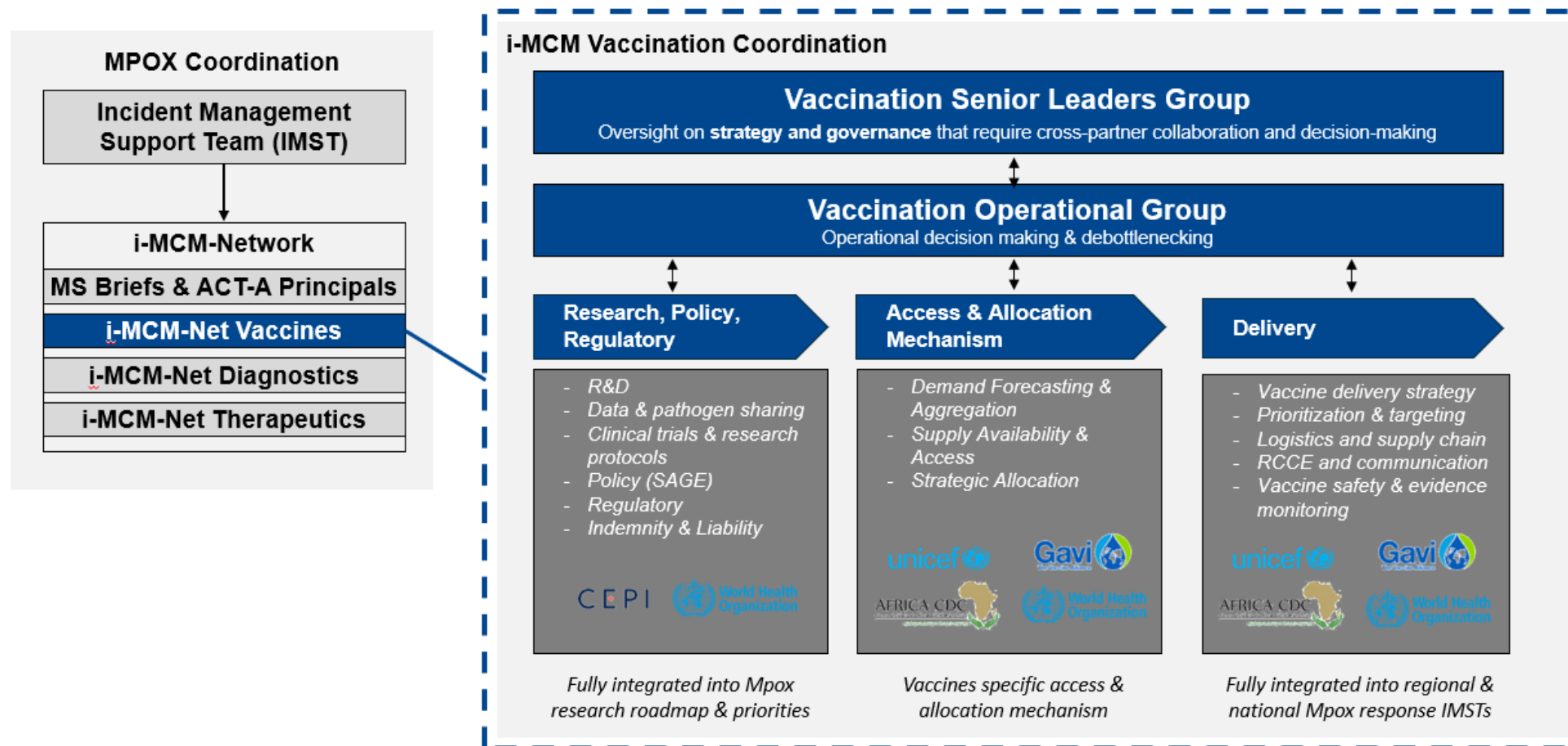
- Global Mpox response financing tracker
- Almost US\$ 577 million committed / pledged for Mpox response efforts



Supply landscape

- 5.9 million doses available (2.9 million MVA-BN and 3 million LC16)
...of which 280k MVA-BN delivered + ~900k MVA-BN recently allocated

Coordination of the mpox vaccination response



Gavi Alliance is playing a key role in the design of the vaccines end-to-end leadership and operational management groups. Alliance leaders and teams will be embedded across the value chain.

Gavi's engagement (highlights)

Preparedness

- Gavi Board approval of mpox stockpile in Gavi 6.0 (subject to replenishment) with associated learning agenda to fill key evidence gaps
- Operationalisation of the First Response Fund following Board approval in June 2024
- Advancing vaccine coalition and contributing to cross-partner collaborative efforts (such as iMCM Net)

Access & Allocation

- Coordination: Coordinating closely across WHO, UNICEF, Africa CDC, countries, donors and other stakeholders.
- Securing supply: Gavi APA with Bavarian Nordic for 500,000 MVA-BN doses by end-2024 – to be delivered by UNICEF via their supply agreement.
- Facilitating donations: Bavarian Nordic donation (15,000 MVA-BN doses) arrived 10 September 2024 in the DRC. Gavi is facilitating donations from two donors following formal requests to the Gavi Secretariat (with allocations via the AAM).

Delivery

- Financing to support vaccination preparation and delivery: Reprogramming of existing grants & targeted vaccination delivery support financed by First Response Fund. US\$ 2.7 million and US\$1.5 million Gavi funding to DRC and Rwanda released.
- Collaboration with Continental IMST and affected countries: Gavi role in multiple pillars of the Continental Plan. Active collaboration with DRC.
- Utilising the vaccine coalition: 3 Africa CDC resources supported via coalition fund repurposed for mpox response.
