Keeping countries and communities central to our collaboration



Guiding Principles

- **Country led and demand driven**
- **Differentiated approach**, leveraging the strengths of each Global Health Institution (GHI)
- **Consideration for operating modalities of each GHI**



High Impact Workstreams

- **Malaria**
- **Health Systems Strengthening** + **Enabling Functions (Gavi-Global Fund)**
- **Country Engagement**



Existing collaboration

- **Investments and programming**
- **Legal, Audit & Investigation, Evaluations**
- **Resource mobilisation, communication, advocacy**



Aligned Communication

- **Consistent communication across Boards and Committees**
- **Clear narrative and strategic messaging to highlight distinct roles, complementarities and impact**

Draft Terms of Reference for Joint Committee Working Group (JCWG)



Purpose



- Ensure a **common vision for the collaboration** and support the Secretariats in identifying opportunities and challenges in **operationalising the 3 priority workstreams** (malaria, health system strengthening, country engagement)

Principles & Mandate



- Keeping long-term **impact for countries and communities at the centre** of the collaboration efforts
- Focus on **how GHIs work and collaborate with each other and with countries**, ensuring GHI efforts are country led and demand driven

Mode of Operation



- Provide additional **guidance and support to the Secretariat workstream leads** to accelerate progress on the collaboration
- **Ensure** various constituents on **Board and Committees have awareness, visibility, and additional space for input** to help shape the collaboration efforts
- **Time-limited, light and agile joint working group** with an initial duration of 12 months (to be confirmed) from its inception and after which time consideration for whether to sunset, extend or adapt the JCWG
- Continue to work through and report to existing governance processes for strategic leadership, decision-making and accountability

Composition



- 1 Secretariat member from each of the 3 GHIs, with sponsorship from Gavi CEO, Global Fund Executive Director, Global Financing Facility Director
- 5 Board or Committee representatives from each of Gavi and Global Fund and 3 for GFF, ensuring inclusive and effective representation

Gavi's relationship with the Africa CDC continues to evolve

- Gavi signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Africa CDC in May 2023
- In October 2023, the two organisations kicked off joint work planning on programming across the MoU Priority Areas
- Currently in the final phase of detailing a support package to Africa CDC for a specific set of activities in Gavi 5.1, including two recent missions to Africa CDC headquarters
- We are also coordinating with other Alliance Partners to understand current areas of support and ensure complementarity
- Looking ahead, planning to jointly design the next phase of the collaboration with Africa CDC and Alliance Partners under Gavi 6.0 and the Partners' Engagement Framework
- Furthermore, Gavi is collaborating with Africa CDC across other efforts, including the African Vaccine Manufacturing Accelerator (AVMA), the Pandemic Fund, the Lusaka Agreement, and more
