# Background

**2016**

**Initiation of Malaria Vaccine Implementation Programme (MVIP)**

**2019**

**Phase 2 funding for MVIP and de-risking continued antigen production**

**October  
2021**

**WHO recommendation for the first malaria vaccine, RTS,S/AS01 (RTS,S)**

**December  
2021**

**Gavi Board approval of a funding window of US\$ 155.7 million, for 2022-2025, which includes funding for Secretariat and Partners' Engagement Framework costs technical assistance and learning activities**

# Malaria vaccine programme design

## Coordination

- Creation of a multi-stakeholder Malaria Vaccine Coordination Team (MVCT)
- Bilateral Gavi – Global Fund collaboration to explore opportunities for additional areas of alignment and synergies

## Vaccine allocation

- Allocation framework to manage limited malaria vaccine doses is being finalised


## Market shaping

- Efforts ongoing to optimise supply and demand for the malaria vaccine
- Full market shaping roadmap will be published Q3 2022

## Funding application guidelines

- Gavi's new Vaccine Funding Guidelines (VFGs) will launch in July 2022
- MVIP countries requested to submit applications to ensure continuity of programmes, non-MVIP countries to submit Expression of Intent (EOI) followed by full application from January 2023
- Specific implications of the updated co-financing policy will only be known with the completion of the funding policy review – December 2022
