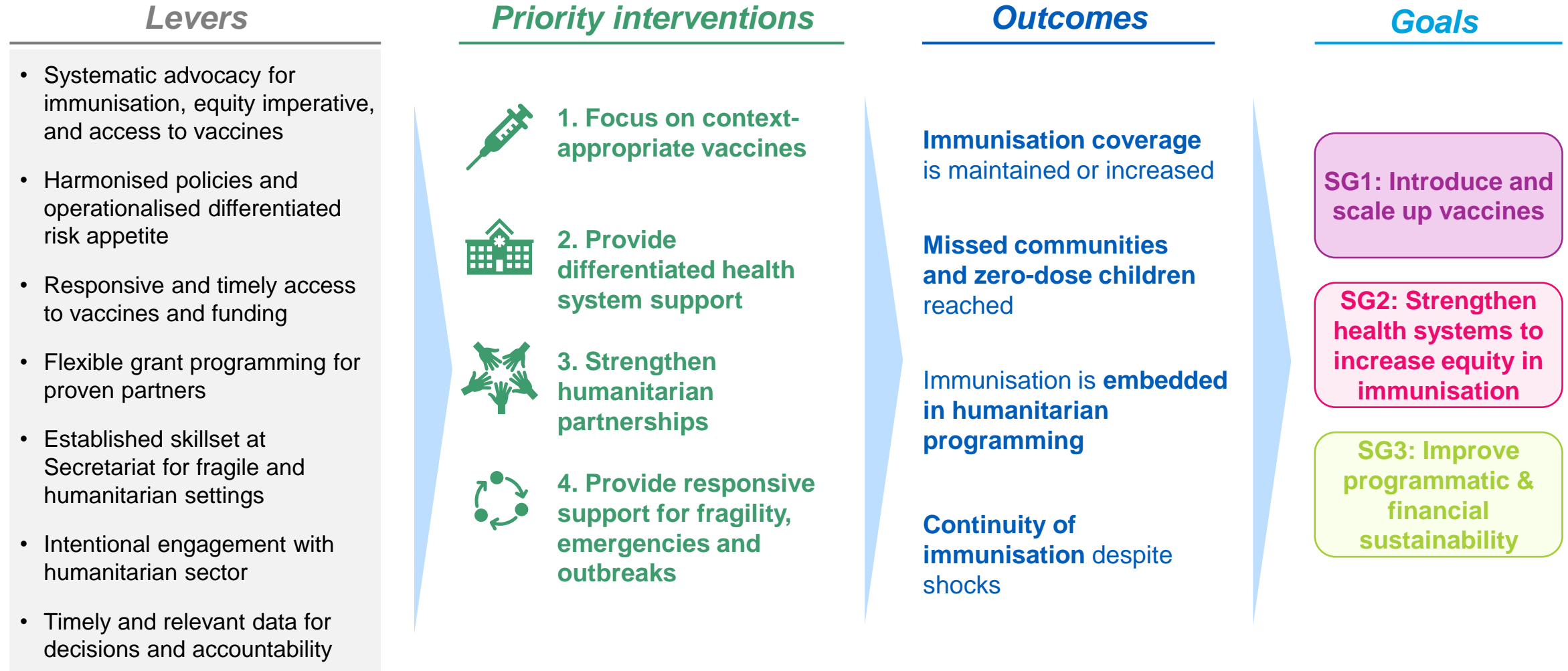

Theory of Change outlines clear levers of influence, interventions, outcomes and goals for the F&H approach







Seven strategic shifts tailor Gavi's delivery model to improve effectiveness in Fragile & Humanitarian settings

- 1 Strengthen and increase coverage with **context-appropriate vaccines**
- 2 **Differentiate health systems support** to missed communities and zero-dose children aged 1-5 years old
- 3 Institute **new ways to direct vaccines and cash** to missed communities
- 4 Support **subnational settings** and **F&H settings** in **catalytic phase countries**
- 5 Establish immunisation as a **humanitarian health practice**
- 6 Create a dedicated '**Gavi Resilience Mechanism**'
- 7 Ensure a **better equipped Gavi Secretariat**



Dedicated Gavi Resilience Mechanism to respond to unforeseen needs, with four use cases

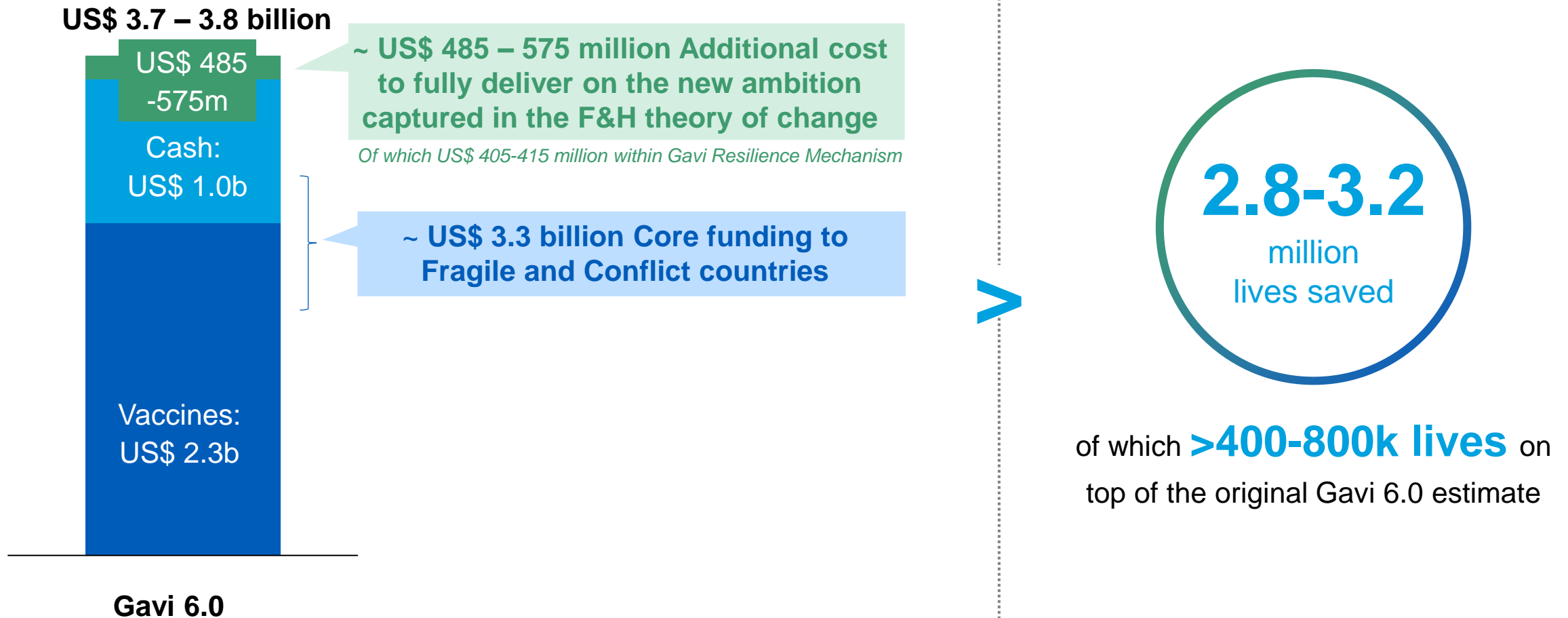
	Newly-arising needs in chronically fragile settings	US\$ 50m
	Emergencies including outbreaks <i>Only outbreak support not covered through existing mechanisms</i>	US\$ 150m
	Settings that require humanitarian programming <i>'ZIP-like', routine immunisation and catch-up for zero-dose children</i>	US\$ 100m
	Catalytic phase countries¹ facing fragility or emergencies <i>Routine immunisation and outbreak response support</i>	US\$ 105-115m

1. Lower-middle income countries or countries eligible to borrow from the International Development Association (IDA-eligible); 2. Of the US\$ 405 - 415 million, US\$ 195 million was already included in the June 2024 Gavi 6.0 cost estimate and entails a reallocation of US\$ 135 million from the Gavi 6.0 HSS ceiling to the GRM. The remaining amounts are additional and included in the updated Gavi 6.0 financial forecast for discussion by the Audit and Finance Committee at its meeting on 17th July 2025

Gavi's Fragile and Humanitarian Approach accelerates 6.0 impact

With US\$ 3.7 – 3.8 billion total investment, 2.8 – 3.2+ million lives would be saved



Recommendation

The Gavi Alliance Programme and Policy Committee **recommends** to the Gavi Alliance Board that it:

- a) **Approve** the Fragile and Humanitarian approach for Gavi 6.0 as outlined in Annex B to Doc 10.
