## Four principles guide the partnership approach, implemented through two levers

		Country ownership	Rebalance towards a country-centric model
	ples	Differentiation	Align TA with Gavi 6.0 top priorities, based on country context, including deliberate focus on country capacity building where relevant
	Princip	Context appropriate partnerships	Systematically leverage comparative strengths of core & other context appropriate partners
		Focus on results	Move to a simplified but rigorous performance management process that focuses on learning and improving results
	Levers	Funding model	Optimise partner support through a streamlined funding model
		Partnerships Accountability framework	Mutual accountability aligned with roles and responsibilities, captured in a result-focused accountability framework



# Lever 1: The Foundational Fund will streamline partner support, replacing the Partners' Engagement Framework

From ~US\$ 1 billion Partners' Engagement Framework in 5.0/5.1...

...To ~US\$ 850 million for partner support in 6.0



**6.0 Foundational Fund (US\$ 492 million), to include:** 


- Global/regional solutions (US\$ 100 million)
- Global/regional foundations (US\$ 199 million)
- Country foundations (US\$ 193 million)

**Consolidated cash grant**, to include the balance of TCA (US\$ 358 million)



## Lever 2: The PAF is a tool to drive mutual accountability between countries, partners and Gavi

The Partnerships Accountability Framework (PAF) is part of the Gavi 6.0 Execution Framework


