Illustrative examples of key initiatives

Action now

- Coordinated applications of GC8/ Gavi 6.0 grant cycle for malaria and HSS, to facilitate integrated planning
- Ensure new HSS/RSSH investments in priority areas consider collaboration opportunities
- Explore joint Secretariat 'indirect procurement' (e.g., IT procurement)

And ~6 more initiatives

For further analysis -

- Harmonisation of co-financing requirements, eligibility, and transition policies
- Assess opportunities for joint offshore/shared services and backoffice integrations (e.g., IT, Ops, ...)
- Opportunities to align or combine independent monitoring and evaluation models

And ~7 more initiatives



Next steps for Gavi-Global Fund collaboration

- Launch of Taskforce (with external provider support) by early Sep
- 2 Development of recommendations by end of 2025
- Decisions on recommendations by Board or Gavi CEO / Global Fund ED, as relevant starting end 2025
