STATEMENT OF SUPPORT

Viruses know no borders, nor should the battle to vanquish them. The world knows only too well the devastating power of pandemics and why we need coordinated global responses to global crises. As the world races to find a vaccine for COVID-19, we must not forget that all too many lives – 1.5 million – are lost every year due to vaccine-preventable diseases.
